

Bethany

Bethany was a village located on the SE slope of the Mt. of Olives, near the road to Jericho [Mark 11: 1-10](#)

, and about 2 miles (3k) from Jerusalem

It was the home of Martha, Mary and Lazarus and of Simon the Leper. Here Jesus often visited [Luke 10: 38-42](#)
